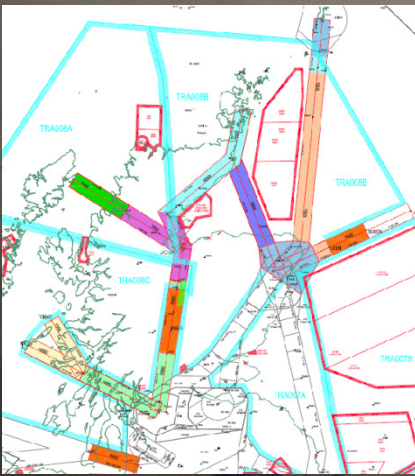


NEW CLASS E AIRSPACE AND ASSOCIATED TMZs IN THE SCOTTISH FIR

All Class F airspace in the UK is being replaced by either Class G or Class E from 13th November



The map above shows the new Class E airways

Clearances:

- IFR flights are subject to an ATC clearance and require 2-way comms
- VFR flights do not require ATC clearance or 2-way comms, subject to compliance with the notified TMZ requirements

Transponder Mandatory Zone (TMZ) chart symbol



Example chart extract

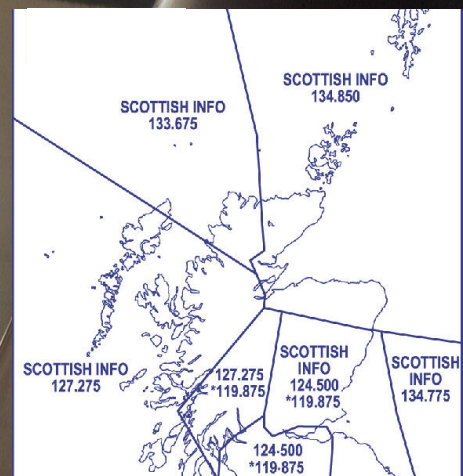


TMZ transponder requirements:

- Functioning Mode S, or
- if not equipped, ATC approval on the appropriate frequency

VFR Flights that are unable to maintain VMC:

- Inform ATC
- if not already in contact, squawk 7700 and contact an appropriate ATSU or D&D (121.5)
